**The band:** Franz Ferdinand, English rockers  
**The style:** Michelle gave them cute English-schoolboy cuts. **Get it:** Girls, why not give this updated punky, pixie cut a try? The hair should be faded up the back to a subtle weight line at the round of the head. Ask for a deep side part that sweeps hair across the forehead. Here's the kicker: In the back, leave about two inches of length at the crown, where your part starts—it'll stick up in that devil-may-care way. Or, slick it down with Suave Professionals Sleek Smoothing Cream, \$2, or Bumble and bumble Grooming Creme, \$22.

**Citizens Band**



**The band:** Citizens Band, a cabaret-style singing troupe including Karen Elson (near left) and rotating guest stars like Maggie Gyllenhaal  
**The style:** Michelle recently styled the performers with romantic, art nouveau bedroom hair, complete with long, wavy extensions and loose braids. (Karen got a powdered white wig with choppy bangs.) **Get it:** For straight-hair girls, work in a styling lotion like Dove Curl Defining Styling Cream, \$4. Once hair is dry, use Hot Tools 3-Barrel Waver, \$35, for quick unkemptness. If you have natural waves, spritz Bumble and bumble Surf Spray, \$18, on damp hair and dry with a diffuser. Now make two veeery loose braids and pin them to the top of your head. Let any renegade pieces fall where they may.

**Kathleen Hanna from Le Tigre**



**The rock star:** Kathleen Hanna from Le Tigre, who's known for her retro beehives and bouffants  
**The style:** Michelle recently cut Kathleen's hair into a jaw-length bob with soft, razor-cut ends (no hard lines or obvious layers) but kept her signature side-swept bangs. **Get it:** This is a low-maintenance style, so Kathleen just sets her damp hair with some Bumble and bumble Tonic, \$16, before drying. When she misses her bouffants of yore, she puts a thickening spray, like Garnier Fructis Body and Volume Root Lifting Spray, \$6, on the crown and teases it up.
